

Train Procedures — Durlin Branch

Extra Durlin Stock

MT stock Chama to Durlin. Load sheep at Durlin and at Fritz Park on return trip

Chama (yard limits)

- Obtain clearance from dispatcher
- · service engine -drop ashes, take water & coal
- · Perform air brake test
- Sign and check train register
- · OS dispatcher on departure

Grandt Line Junction

Stop and line switch for branch

Cresco

Water stop for T-12 and C class engines

Toltec Gorge

Slow order 5mph

Carrumba (yard limits)

- · Check train order board, obtain clearance
- Water stop for all engines
- · Sign and check train register
- Cut off helper engine
- OS dispatcher on departure from Carrumba

Fritz Par

- Set out empty stock cars in siding for loading on return trip, set wheel chock to avoid run-a -way
- · Set up retainers and run air brake test

Durlin (vard limits)

- OS dispatcher, sign train register
- Spot cars at stock chute, use sheep sound to time loading of each car
- Service engine, assemble train of stock loads headed westward
- · Obtain orders and clearance from dispatcher
- · Perform air brake test
- · OS dispatcher on departure of time sheep loaded

Fritz Park

- Load empties on siding. Use Sheep sound to time loading of each car or pair of cars
- · Assemble train, run air brake test
- · Call dispatcher and OS with time stock loaded

Carrumba (yard limits) - See above


Cresco - Cool wheels 10 minutes


Grandt Line Jtn. – Call Chama yard for track assignment Chama (yard limits)


- OS dispatcher, sign register
- Hostel engine per YM instructions, check for new orders, if none go off duty

- Covers the trip from terminal to terminal
- Describes the activity or what is to be done at each point on the RR
- Does not describe how to do it
- Does not grant authority to occupy mainline
- Printed on the back cover of the "Train Wallet"
